Dear Pastor:

Thank you for your continued initiative to reach our community with the message of Jesus Christ. Many young people in our church are ready to follow your commitment and serve as campus missionaries to their respective junior and senior high schools.

The greatest mission field in America is our school campuses. Approximately 80 percent of the millions of students on America's middle and high school campuses do not attend church regularly. Upon the approval of the campus missionary applicants, we can officially commission them to their mission field. I ask that we publicly acknowledge them in one of our regular worship services. This will build responsibility in the campus missionary and build support from the congregation. We also have official certificates to recognize their appointment. I encourage you to place them in a prominent place in our church.
