



INCLUDE (WEEK 1) SMALL GROUPS—LOVE

Purpose: To allow all students present to voice their opinion on what they believe love truly is.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Refreshments

SAMPLE MEETING AGENDA

1. Pre-meeting prayer (leaders)
2. Welcome and attendance
3. Announcements
 - Next week's guest speaker
 - Evangelism blitz outreach
 - Pre-outreach assignments
4. Discussion
5. Biblical support and application (small groups)
6. Prayer/dismiss



DISCUSSION:

Divide students into groups of four or five. Have a student leader in each group coordinate the discussion on what true love really is. Have student leaders compile a list of the best answers to be used later at the evangelism blitz. Ask the student leaders to share a positive and negative experience of love and how it affected their lives. (This should open up the channels of communication.) Have the student leaders lead the Biblical support and application in the small groups.

BIBLICAL SUPPORT AND APPLICATION:

1. Love must be genuine (Romans 12:9).
2. Love never quits (1 Corinthians 13:4-8).
3. God is love (1 John 4:16). Show others true love. The world around us (especially students in this school) is searching for something that is real.



INSPIRE (WEEK 2) GUEST SPEAKER—LOVE

Purpose: To encourage sexual abstinence and purity until marriage through the use of a guest speaker.

BEFORE THE MEETING:

- Meet with guest speaker and give him/her the topic, maintaining sexual purity, and any guidelines concerning when and how to close the meeting.
- Inform speaker of the day, time and locations of the club.
- Select a student to meet the speaker at the office, help him/her sign in as a visitor and take the speaker to the meeting room.
- Select a student to introduce the guest speaker.
- Contact your speaker several days in advance to confirm all details.
- Keep all issues biblical and non-denominational.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Guest speaker
- Refreshments

INVOLVE (WEEK 3) STUDENT SPEAKERS—LOVE

Purpose: To show how we need to love others in order to reach others for Christ.

BEFORE THE MEETING:

- Ask two or three students to share how God has changed their lives through love.
- Using 1 John 4:16 as their key passage, have them develop their own short outline.
- Ask a youth pastor to review the written testimonies and give suggestions.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Refreshments

PRAYER/DISMISS:

Take ample time to pray and announce next week's speaker. Challenge the group to bring students next week who need to know about real love.

SUGGESTION:

If this meeting is held near Valentine's Day hand out valentines as invitations.





INVEST (WEEK 4) OUTREACH EVENT—LOVE

Purpose: To see students touched by the saving power of Jesus Christ and to see your campus transformed.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Food/breakfast.
- Ask a church to sponsor the cost as an evangelistic investment.
- Response cards and pens

BEFORE THE MEETING:

- Think creatively of ways to make your friends want to come to this outreach.
- Secure your speaker several weeks in advance and give him/her these guidelines.
 1. Be prepared to ask the students to accept Christ at the conclusion of the service.
 2. Speak confidently.
 3. Keep in mind the purpose of this week's service. Response cards will be handed out.
- Select members to be responsible for distributing and collecting response cards as well as planning for effective follow-up.

SAMPLE MEETING AGENDA

1. Pre-meeting prayer (leaders)
2. Welcome and attendance
3. Announcements (date, time, and location of next meeting)
4. Introduce student speaker
5. Student testimony/gospel presentation
6. Invitation, prayer, response cards
7. Dismiss/initial follow-up
