



Five Ways to Give \$100 to Missions in One Year

- 1. Go hungry so others can be spiritually fed.**
 - Give up lunch one day a week during school year (36 weeks X \$2 = \$72).
 - Give up one fast food meal every other month (6 months X \$5 = \$30).
- 2. Refuse gifts so others can experience God's free gift.**
 - Ask for money at Christmas, birthday, graduation, and other special occasions. Give the money to Speed the Light.
- 3. Serve so others can be served.**
 - Give \$5 a month from your allowance (12 X \$5 = \$60).
 - Mow someone's lawn, rake their leaves, haul off their trash, wash their car, baby-sit, etc., and give the money to Speed the Light (\$40).
- 4. Sacrifice so others can understand the ultimate sacrifice.**
 - Give an extra 10 percent of your income from all of your jobs throughout the year (\$100).
- 5. Create awareness so others can become aware of the Creator.**
 - Write a letter explaining how missionaries are helping people all over the world. Go to www.youth.ag.org/discipleship. Click on "E-mail a Missionary" to get a few stories of how Speed the Light is making a difference. Send your letter out to ten people asking if they would give \$10 to help reach people (10 people X \$10 = \$100).
